

This Memorandum of Understanding herein after referred to as "AGREEMENT" and is made and entered on the 25th day of Sept Month of 2014 (Year).

A. Objectives and Scope of Agreement

This memorandum is signed with the objective to develop cooperation among the three institutions being established by mutual written agreement and with mutual interest.

The areas of the "Agreement" include academic and research activities or programmes offered at either institution that will constitute fostering or development of the cooperative relationship among them.

Each institution will offer mutually to the other institutions, opportunities for activities and programmes, such as, development of newer courses, undertaking collaborative research projects, exchange of faculty and students and staff development that will foster and develop the collaborative relationship.

This agreement will focus on medical and pharmaceutical professional education, effective utilization of personnel resources, scientific potential, acquisition, enhancement of theoretical and practical activities skills and improvement of quality of training, expansion and strengthening of scientific communications and research.

The mutual interest in the fields of Research, Development, Education, Training, Transfer of technology will disseminate knowledge for long- term benefits and help mutually to recognize the importance of institutions in higher education bringing international collaboration and ultimately leading to increased contribution to the social development.

This agreement aims to provide opportunities for global experience, advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts, mutual benefit and frequent interactions.

B) DPSRU, STSMU and ICMER agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:

- a) Exchange of Information on Research, Conducting Joint Research Projects, Teaching, Learning Materials and other Literature Relevant to their Educational, Scientific and Research Programmes;
- b) Joint Organization of Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and Short-term / Long-term Continuing Education Programmes on topics of mutual interest, while extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- c) Exchange on a reciprocal basis of students at Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purposes of education and/or research.
- d) Competency based Teaching through formal, Structured Practice motivated by Coaching, Simulation, Knowledge, Skill and Practice.
- e) Conducting online Medical / Pharmaceutical Sciences Programmes.
- f) Deputation of our Professors and Exchange of Faculties among DPSRU , STSMU and ICMER
- g) Joint Scholarly Publications and Research.
- h) Social, Cultural, Health and Family Welfare Programmes.
- i) Entering into tie-ups with the local Medical / Pharmaceutical Institutions, Health Care Providers and Laboratories, Leading Scanning Centres for imparting necessary skills and Training for the Postgraduate and Doctoral Medical and Pharmaceutical Students.
- j) Preparing Effective Curricular Activities to meet the International Standards in accordance with the Syllabus of the Universities.
- k) Providing Teaching-Learning and Evaluation Measures, Research, Consultancy and Extension, Students Support Service and Progression Governance.

C. Co-ordination

The ICMER is entitled to pursue the co-ordination of collaboration and all follow- on meetings

D. Tenure and Termination

The agreement will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the three institutions. The terms of this agreement may be amended by mutual written agreement. Any extension to this agreement will be formally agreed in writing by the Institutions.

E. Intellectual Property

DPSRU, STSMU and ICMER agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. All Background IP used in connection with this agreement shall remain the property of the Party that introduces it. No license is granted to any Party to use another Party's Background IP unless specifically agreed to in writing. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or joint activity under this agreement would be subject to separate written agreement/s on the ownership and management of such intellectual property and each Party agrees to respect the ownership of IP of the other Parties in all dealings, consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the partner Institutions.

No Party to this Memorandum shall use the name, logo or any other designation of any of the other Parties without prior written consent.


F. Arbitration Clause


